

### **What is PPVote?**

PowerPointVote is a voting tool which uses Microsoft Powerpoint. It allows the user to turn normal slides into interactive voting elements within an existing presentation. It is similar to the "Ask the Audience" option in the popular TV show 'Who Wants to be a Millionaire?'

### **How does it work?**

Each delegate uses a small radio keypad to register their answer as interactive slides are presented. The results for each slide are recorded on the computer running the presentation and can be shown instantly to the audience.

### **Why use PPVote?**

The entire audience is engaged using their voting keypads. The system is **democratic** – one person one vote!

**anonymous** – no-one knows how each person voted!

**instant** - results displayed immediately!

**fun** - start your event with a quick quiz to get everyone involved!

### **How do I see the results?**

During the event graphs of results can be displayed instantly on screen. Captured data can also be used later to produce detailed analysis for formal reports.

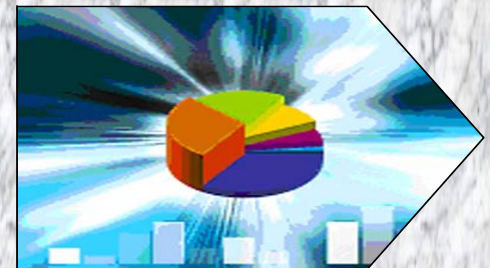
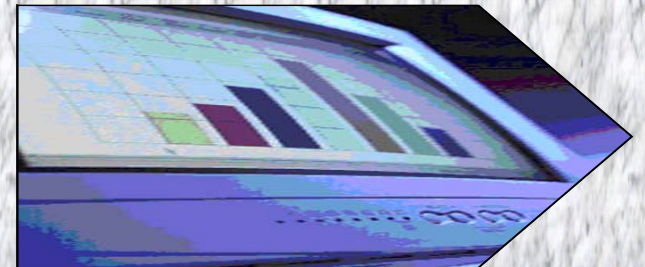
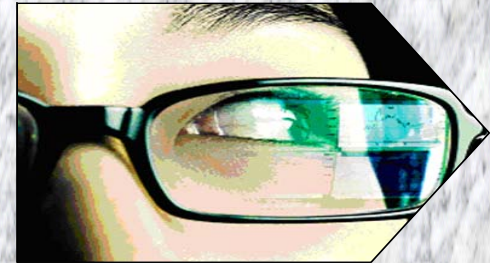

# PPVote can dramatically improve your presentations, surveys and consultations!



## What does it do?

Question slides are loaded into a PowerPoint presentation. When these appear the audience can vote using a small radio keypad to register their answer. The results can be presented back through PowerPoint to give the audience instant feedback. Findings from different questions or repeated surveys can be combined in order to create global data. After the presentation the results can be viewed as graphs or in a spreadsheet to be incorporated into a final report.

The system can be hired out or REAP can be commissioned to run an entire consultation event. REAP can offer a package to suit your requirements and budget.

**The Complete Package** REAP can design your presentation then set up and operate the technology on the day of your event. If required REAP can facilitate the meeting.
